

## • Infant, Toddler & Two Groups (6 weeks - 2 years)

Our infant & toddler programs are focused on safe and nurturing environments, where each child can play, learn and grow individually, while also building new relationships. Our goal is to create a strong bond with each child, while providing the most beneficial environment and experiences to meet their rapidly developing abilities. Our staff will sing, read and interact with your child to aid them with this important time. We will provide age-appropriate toys, games and music activities throughout the day.

## • Pre-School and Pre-Kindergarten (3,4 or 5 years old)

Pre-School programs are offered mornings, Monday through Friday. These programs are designed to give children an introduction to the learning environment, and prepare them for advancement (to our Pre-K room, or Kindergarten in the fall). Pre-School drop off runs from 9-9:15am, and concludes with pick up times from 11:15-11:30am. Each session includes a healthy snack, gross motor time, skill building activities, music and story time.

## • Before & After Kindergarten (5-6 years old)

## • School Age Care (age 6 & up)

A staff member will accompany New Lenox School District Kindergarteners to and from the designated bus stop each day. This program also includes a rest period, snack and a nutritious hot lunch.

Transportation for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> graders will be provided to a selective few of the New Lenox grade schools (*please contact the director for list of schools*). This program also includes an afternoon snack.

While in our care, both the kindergarteners and School-Agers will benefit by participating in skill review and/or homework assistance. The planned schedule for this group includes literacy skill building, math concept activities, music and more.
